Subscription-based LGBT network here!TV, continues to bring racy, and entertaining programming to the small screen.

Arriving soon from the U.K. is the drama series *Sugar Rush*, expected to premiere in December. Based on the Julie Burchill novel of the same name, the series follows the life of 15-year-old Kim (Olivia Hallinan), who is doing her best to survive adolescence as part of a family she would rather do without, and crushing on her best friend Maria Sweet (Lenora Crichlow).

Season three of the over-the-top, steamy drama *Paradise Falls* has been in full swing since April. This queer soap is set in a not-so-quiet Canadian beachside town, where Cate (Meredith McGeachie) is the sexiest lesbian cop around (McGeachie is most familiar to *L Word* watchers as Tonya, Dana's season two stalker/girlfriend.) Things heat up when Cate falls into a hot romance with the outspokenly bisexual Trish (Michelle Latimer), but things get sticky when Cate's ex-GF Julie (Kerry Lai Fatt) is added to the mix.

Premiering September 5 is season two of *Lesbian Sex and Sexuality*, another here!TV original. The documentary series which delves into sexuality, gender and controversial LGBT issues, is produced and directed by the award-winning filmmaker Katherine Linton. Episodes include themes of "high camp"; lesbian burlesque; queer porn star Lorelei Lee; the difference between butch, femme and everything in-between; the stereotype-killing renaissance of the lesbian one-night stand; lesbian escorts; lesbian sex at The Dinah; and tips and advice from sexperts.

The sci-fi drama series *Dante's Cove* will be airing reruns of season three throughout the fall. Catch up on any episodes you might have missed, as Michelle (Jill Bennett) finds herself caught in a love triangle with Brit (Michelle Wolff)—the hottest oceanographer-by-day/bartender-by-night on the island—and Elena, played by actor and model Jenny Shimizu who most recently appeared in the lesbian themed feature *Itty Bitty Titty Committee*.

Premiering on October 3 is here! with Josh and Sara. The talk show features interviews and guest appearances and deals with topics of interest to the gay and lesbian community. Josh Rosenzweig and Sara Logue are ready to take their witty repartee with the top talent in the gay community from their already popular podcast to TV. The show will include appearances from Swati, I Heart Brooklyn Girls and Martina Navratilova.

Also premiering on October 3 is another new series, *Murder.com*. The show's leading character, Stacy (played by Alexandra Paul of Baywatch fame), is a high-powered South Beach lesbian lawyer who returns home when her estranged sister, Kate, is killed by an unknown assailant. The season unfolds as Stacy takes the investigation into her own hands and uncovers disturbing revelations about a sister that she barely knew. Somewhere along the road, romance blooms for Stacy, but we won't spoil the surprise by saying which of her good friends will ultimately become her girlfriend!
